Do you want to be confident that your workplace is not impacted by alcohol and other drugs (AOD)? What are the options and what are the pros and cons of each? What is legally robust? What is best practice? No single set of policy levers works in all settings.

Topics covered include:

- Should a program incorporate testing?
- What matrix?
- How often?
- Who should be tested?
- What if there is a positive?
- How should the test results get to the MRO?
- Should industries require rehabilitation?

The workshop is a highly interactive one-day session at the end of which you will have learnt the answers to many questions, and more importantly, will know where and when to question the policy decisions. At the end of the workshop, you will also have created a 'core' document based on your specific context, that you can further refine after consultation.
